For all its institutional idiocy, I find here a tradition of reason. For all the individualistic experiences, I breathe here an air of freedom. For all the false fear of sexuality, I discover here the redemption of my body. In an age so inhumane, I touch here the tears of compassion. In a world so grim and humorless, I share here rich joy and earthly laughter. In the midst of death, I hear here an incomparable stress on life. For all the apparent absence of God, I sense here the real, living loving presence of Jesus the Christ, the God-Man." !




