Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48; 1 John 4:7-10; John 15:9-17



At first, Jesus' command to his friends sounds too easy to be true. All we have to do is love. But this is easier said than done. It is less complicated, but much harder than the lists of do's and don't's that we learned in catechism. Jesus' love is a total self-giving, a letting go of our own ego, a pure desire to serve even those who don't seem to appreciate our gift of self. If we are to love in this way, it helps to know that kind of love first – the kind of love that forgives our unkind remarks, our thoughtless actions, our meanness. And to accept that kind of love is to let go of our own, sometimes harsh self criticism. When we act in love, we tend to receive love in return, which helps us to love ourselves more gently, and understand Jesus' love more fully. It is a circle of love – jump in anywhere and see what love can do in your life!
