ASSUMPTION RESTORATION FUND UPDATE

Dear Parishioners,

As you know, Assumption Parish Leadership and the Diocese of London recently terminated our fundraising contract with Philanthropic Management Consultants Inc. (PMC), giving the required 120 days notice on February 20, 2012. Despite requests, we have not received a full accounting of the campaign, including financial results, from either PMC or Assumption Heritage Trust Foundation (AHTF). We have requested the resignation of the President of AHTF but that request was denied.

Once the termination becomes effective on June 19, 2012, we will conduct an evaluation and report the results.

We are thankful to all those who have given generously to the campaign. However, given the issues mentioned, it is advised that you cease making donations at this time, including stopping any automatic withdrawals from your bank account. The parish has been withholding donations received through Sunday collections since the notice of termination. These funds could be returned to you if you so choose or kept with the parish until a new direction is announced.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Please know that we are doing everything possible in this difficult situation.
