**Sixth Sunday of Easter
May 5, 2013**

Acts 15:1-2,22-29; Rev. 21:10-14, 22-23; John 14:23-29



Jesus is leaving his disciples and returning to the Father, whose will he has always done. Now his followers must live by his word, which is not his own but his Father's. How important is that word! Christ and the Father will live with those who keep God's word and its meaning for our lives. We need not worry, for Jesus leaves us his peace, which is so different from the world's. God's dwelling in us, Jesus' legacy, is represented by the holy city described in Revelation. There is no temple in that radiant city because God's glory completely fills it. We, God's people, are his sanctuary. The report in Acts of the Council of Jerusalem show that differences of opinion are nothing new in the Church: similar disagreements should not disturb God's people today. If we accept the Holy Spirit's guidance, we shall arrive together at the decision God wants. Remember that Lord has promised "I will not leave you orphans".
