From the Administrator's Desk...

The readings that we hear this weekend are very timely as we consider the current state of affairs in our world. It seems like everywhere we look, we are constantly seeing reports of violence, war, people who are mistreating others, people who are only looking out for themselves: the list goes on and on. How do we as people of faith respond in times such as these?

Jesus gives us a powerful answer in the Gospel, when he answers the question of the Pharisees about the greatest commandment. In his response, Jesus reminds us that the love of God and love of our neighbour go hand in hand, and that both are necessary to fulfill God's commandments. In his First Letter, Saint John makes this quite clear when he says: "Those who say, "I love God," and hate their brothers or sisters, are liars; for those who do not love a brother or sister whom they have seen, cannot love God whom they have not seen. The commandment we have from him is this: those who love God must love their brothers and sisters also." (1 John 4:20-21)

Our first reading makes it clear that our neighbour is not just those that we find it easy to get along with. In speaking to the Israelites, the Lord reminds the chosen people that they are to have special concern for the immigrants living among them, since they were once immigrants in the land of Egypt. He also reminds the people to not oppress widows, orphans, or the poor and marginalized.

Imagine how different the world could be if we actually lived by these commandments: if we truly treated everyone around us with love, dignity, and respect. Imagine how many conflicts would cease to exist because we learned to put aside our differences and treat one another as human beings, instead of demonizing those we do not agree with.

These readings remind us that we are called to be the example to others: to show others what it means to live by the commandments and give witness to our faith. The more we can do that, the more we can inspire others to imitate our example. When this becomes difficult to do, we are called to recognize that our strength comes from the Lord. When we find it difficult to love our neighbours as we should, we can turn to God in prayer, and ask for the grace to love that person, and to recognize their dignity as a son or daughter of God. Doing so will help us to make the world a nicer place, one small action at a time.


