From the Administrator's Desk.....

It might seem strange to us that in today's Gospel, Jesus is praising a dishonest steward for his actions. On the surface, it looks like he is cheating his master out of money by lowering the debts of his master's debtors! However, I would imagine that the reason this steward acted in this way is because he had been charging the debtors more than they actually owed to support his desired lifestyle. That is why the master commends the steward: because in the end, he did what was right, so that he might save grace with those he defrauded.

We have to be careful with how we interpret this passage, though. The lesson is not simply "its ok to defraud one's neighbour, as long as you make it right if you get caught." The lesson is that it is better to live a life of honesty, integrity, and decency in all things, so that we might be found worthy to enter the Kingdom of God. This is why Jesus cautions us in the Gospel that we cannot serve two masters. If we serve the things of this world, we will lose sight of the things that will help us to get to Heaven. By serving God alone, we can ensure that we do not become overly attached to the things of this world, and that we keep our sights set on God alone.

This weekend, I want to take a moment to publicly thank Jessica Jarvis for her service to our Family of Parishes as our Coordinator of Youth Ministry for the past two and a half years. Jessica has chosen to step down from this position in order to spend more time with her family. Jessica's dedication to guiding our youth and Sacramental programs through the uncertainties of the COVID-19 pandemic cannot be understated. We owe her a debt of gratitude for working to deliver these programs in the midst of constantly changing circumstances. I want to wish Jessica all the best in her future endeavours- know that you are always welcome in our Family of Parishes!

I also want to extend to all of you a special invitation to attend our Family of Parishes Festival next weekend. It is shaping up to be a wonderful event, which will allow us to celebrate the rich diversity of our Family of Parishes. We are excited to have representatives of all of our communities participating in the Mass at 11:30 am at St. Angela's, followed by food, informational displays, and entertainment. We are dealing with two themes this week. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has written a pastoral letter called "**The Co-responsibility of the lay faithful in the Church and in the World.**" The letter explores the great responsibility of the laity in God's plan for the world, in which we are not simply collaborators of the clergy but are truly "co-responsible" for the Church's being and acting. Next Sunday September 25th is the Windsor Heritage Catholic Family of Parishes Festival which will be held at the St. Angela Merici Parish site, beginning with 11:30am mass for all the communities in our family of parishes, followed by food, activities, entertainment, and an open house style of learning about each of the communities and church associations in our family of parishes. The event will conclude with a prayer walk to St. Alphonsus and the opportunity to end the day with the 5:30pm mass there. The 11:30am mass at St. Angela is the Festival celebration of our family of parishes. There will still be an 11am mass at Assumption and a noon mass at St. Alphonsus, though they will be without the usual music and liturgical ministries we ordinarily have in place.

Hoping for a large crowd, we recognize parking is a challenge. We encourage you to use street and surrounding city parking if you are able easily walk to the site. There will not be any street closures so feel free to drop off those who have difficulty with mobility at the church before parking. The day is designed so that people may come and go at any time through out the afternoon and have an opportunity for mass at the beginning or the end of the celebration. We hope you will join in the celebration!

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is for those who are seeking the sacraments of baptism, confirmation and Eucharist. If you have missed any of those sacraments and would like to hear more about the process through which you can prepare to receive them now is the time to contact us. If in your family you have children over 7 years old who are not yet baptized and you wish for this to happen, then the RCIA process will be made available to your family at the child's level of learning. 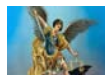
