From The Administrators Desk . . .

Several years ago, I attended a large Catholic conference in Anaheim, CA. approximately 25,000 people were in attendance, and the workshops were given by well-known presenters from all over the world. There was one presenter that really surprised me, though. The keynote speaker for that particular year was Pastor Rick Warren, Pastor of Saddleback Church in Lake Forest, CA, and author of the book *The Purpose Driven Life*. When I read this in the conference guide, my first reaction was "This is a Catholic conference- why are they inviting an evangelical Pastor to speak at a Catholic conference?" I very quickly got a dose of humility, though, when I realized that I took more away from Rick Warren's talk than I did from some of the other presentations I attended. Even though he is not Catholic, he has a deep respect and admiration for the Catholic tradition, which shone through in his talk, and helped us all to relate to the words he spoke. Had I chosen not to attend that session simply because of who was presenting, I would have missed out on a valuable lesson.

Jesus addresses a very similar occurrence in today's Gospel. John wants to discredit someone who is driving out demons in the name of Jesus, because he is not a "regular" follower. He doesn't live by all the rules we have to live by, so why should he be able to cast out demons? And yet, if that person didn't have faith in Jesus, they would not be able to drive out demons in his name. In reminding his disciples that "whoever is not against us is for us," Jesus reminds us that God's grace often works in ways that we do not expect. If we allow jealousy to creep in, and dismiss a person because they don't follow Jesus the "right" way, we may well miss the chance to see God's grace at work among us. At the end of the day, what unites us as Christians is far stronger than what divides us. If we were to truly focus on what unites us as Christians, imagine the difference it would make!

How do we accomplish this, though? How do we work for unity in the midst of so much division and hatred? Jesus gives us the answer at the end of today's Gospel, when he tells us to "cut off" those parts of ourselves that cause us to sin. The challenge here is to recognize what leads us into sin. Is it judgmental attitudes? Envy? A lack of concern for our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ? From there, we can ask God for his grace and help to amend our lives, so that we can experience God's mercy, grow in holiness, and become more open to the presence of God in everyone we meet.

Diversi anni fa, ho partecipato ad una grande conferenza cattolica ad Anaheim, CA. Erano presenti circa 25.000 persone e i workshop erano tenuti da noti presentatori provenienti da tutto il mondo. C'era un presentatore che mi ha davvero sorpreso, però. L'oratore principale di quell'anno particolare era il pastore Rick Warren, pastore della Saddleback Church a Lake Forest, CA, e autore del libro *The Purpose Driven Life*. Quando ho letto questo nella guida della conferenza, la mia prima reazione è stata "Questa è una conferenza cattolica - perché invitano un pastore evangelico a parlare ad una conferenza cattolica? Ho avuto molto rapidamente una dose di umiltà, però, quando mi sono reso conto che ho preso di più dal discorso di Rick Warren che da alcune delle altre presentazioni a cui ho partecipato. Anche se non è cattolico, ha un profondo rispetto e ammirazione per la tradizione cattolica, che traspariva nel suo discorso, e ci ha aiutato tutti a relazionarci con le parole che ha detto. Se avessi scelto di non partecipare a quella sessione semplicemente a causa di chi stava presentando, avrei perso una lezione preziosa.

Gesù affronta un fatto molto simile nel Vangelo di oggi. Giovanni vuole screditare qualcuno che scaccia i demoni nel nome di Gesù, perché non è un seguace "regolare". Non vive secondo tutte le regole che dobbiamo seguire noi, quindi perché dovrebbe essere in grado di scacciare i demoni? Eppure, se quella persona non avesse fede in Gesù, non sarebbe in grado di scacciare i demoni nel suo nome. Ricordando ai suoi discepoli che "chi non è contro di noi è per noi", Gesù ci ricorda che la grazia di Dio spesso opera in modi che non ci aspettiamo. Se permettiamo alla gelosia di insinuarsi e respingiamo una persona perché non segue Gesù nel modo "giusto", potremmo perdere la possibilità di vedere la grazia di Dio all'opera tra noi. Alla fine della giornata, ciò che ci unisce come cristiani è molto più forte di ciò che ci divide. Se ci concentrassimo veramente su ciò che ci unisce come cristiani, immaginate la differenza che farebbe!

Come facciamo a realizzare questo, però? Come possiamo lavorare per l'unità in mezzo a tanta divisione e odio? Gesù ci dà la risposta alla fine del Vangelo di oggi, quando ci dice di "tagliare via" quelle parti di noi stessi che ci fanno peccare. La sfida qui è riconoscere cosa ci porta al peccato. Sono atteggiamenti giudicanti? L'invidia? Una mancanza di preoccupazione per i nostri fratelli e sorelle in Cristo? Da lì, possiamo chiedere a Dio la sua grazia e il suo aiuto per emendare la nostra vita, in modo da poter sperimentare la misericordia di Dio, crescere in santità e diventare più aperti alla presenza di Dio in chiunque incontriamo.
