TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Exodus: 32:7-14; 1 Timothy 1:12-17; Luke 15:1-32

“The Kingdom of Heaven is like a woman lighting a lamp
in search of the one coin of great value....”

Today's parables defend Jesus' ministry and table fellowship with sinners. God's active search for the lost and great joy at their return is illustrated in the woman who discovers a lost coin and the shepherd who finds the missing sheep.

In the first reading, Moses acts like Christ our mediator; he intercedes for the Israelites who have lapsed into idolatry.

In the first letter to Timothy, Paul acknowledges his great sinfulness.

The apostle is proof that Jesus really wants to save us.

"AN INSIDE LOOK INTO THE PAPAL TRANSITION"

Following the announcement on February 11, 2013 that His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI would resign from the papacy, Fr. Thomas Rosica, C.S.B., was invited by the Vatican to join the staff of the Holy See Press Office and serve as one of the official spokespersons for the transition in the papacy that included the resignation, Conclave and election of the new Pope.

During this special Christian Culture Lecture and Dinner, Fr. Rosica will speak to us on what it was like to be an eyewitness to history in the making that began with the resignation of Pope Benedict XVI and culminated in the surprise election of Pope Francis, the first Pope from the Americas.
