LABOUR DAY WEEKEND

Deut. 4:1-8; Ps. 14; James 1:17-27; Mark 7:1-23



How much easier it is for us to canonize our human traditions, especially those relating to faith and worship, than to be converted! In today's gospel, Jesus condemns the attitude which argues over externals, separates the sacred from real life, and think that scrupulous following of human regulations appeases God. Everything God has created is good; whether God's good gifts are used for good or evil depends on our intention. In Deuteronomy, the law code of the Old Testament, we discover that God's law is more than a series of commands. It is the outward expression of encounter with God in the depths of our hearts. God has made a covenant, or agreement in love, with us. Obedience to God's law is acted out in our wholehearted and loving following of God into the promised land, into the fullness of life. Our loving obedience will speak of God's love to the world. The letter of James, today, urges us to do more than listen to God's word; we are to follow it. What better way to demonstrate our dependence on our Father than to love those who are most needy!



For the gift of work, we are grateful in this prayer. We are thankful for the dignity and creative challenge of our unique tasks. For the work that ennobles us, that lifts up our spirits, we are grateful. By means of these labours, we are able to give flesh to our spiritual dreams and to work out the salvation of the earth. We take time this weekend to thank You, O God, for those common tasks that we must perform each day, those necessary labours of life by which, according to Your divine plan, we are also able to make way for Your kingdom here in our midst. We daily follow in the footsteps of Jesus, the carpenter of Nazareth, and in the way of Mary, His mother, who gracefully worked with Joseph, as we rejoice in the opportunities for work that form us in Your love. With St. Paul the tent-maker, with St. Peter, the fisherman, we too labour in love as we proclaim the mysteries of Your Gospel of good news. Help us, Lord our God, to use the work of each day—to perform it with mindfulness and attention, with care and devotion—that it will be a healing for us and for all the earth. Blessed are You, Lord our God, who enhances our lives with work. Amen.
