## **SSVP Monthly PAD Change as of August**

The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul (SSVP) wants to take this opportunity to thank those who donate monthly through the St. Paul the Apostle pre-authorized debit program (PAD). Monthly donations are needed now more than ever due to the increased demand for regular monthly assistance to our neighbours.

Effective for your August 2022 PAD, the SSVP portion of your monthly PAD will be withdrawn from your bank account using our new SSVP payment processing platform. The SSVP and church are separate entities with separate banking arrangements and this change recognizes and facilitates that distinction. Letters were mailed from SSVP to each SSVP monthly donor the week of July 11<sup>th</sup>. This mailing includes an authorization form to be completed and returned by August 15<sup>th</sup>. SSVP cannot continue to withdraw your monthly PAD donation as of August if this form is not received, so kindly watch for this letter. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and generosity.
