

Advent Wreath Lighting Ceremony

Fourth Week: "Blest is she who trusted that the Lord's words to her would be fulfilled." (Luke 1:45) In the Fourth Week of Advent, we consider Mary's trust in God's promise, her joy in His goodness to her. We ask, "Am I ready to receive and celebrate the coming of the Son of God." We have considered our relationships, our love for God and God's love for us, and we have responded with an awakened concern for the needs of others. Now we may echo Mary's words, "My being proclaims the greatness of the Lord. My spirit finds joy in God my Saviour." (Light the fourth candle)
