Lent is Coming!

Ash Wednesday in on February 22nd. This day marks the beginning of the penitential season of Lent where we prepare to celebrate Easter in 40 days by prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We will have 3 masses on Ash Wednesday at 9:00 am, 12 noon and 7:00 pm. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at all the Masses.

Fasting and abstaining from meat is one of the precepts of the Catholic Church. All Catholics are required to follow the Precepts of the Church as a minimum standard to be considered a practicing Catholic. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the 2 days of abstinence in Canada, where all Catholics who are 14 years old and above are obliged to abstain from meat. The norm for the Universal Church is that all Fridays are days of abstinence, but the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops decreed that a special act of charity or piety can substitute the abstinence on the other Fridays throughout the year.

The days of fasting in Canada are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Catholics between 18 and 60 are required to fast on these days. There are no special guidelines for what "fasting" means in Canada, but as an example of what a fast might look like, in the United States, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Lent is a great opportunity of grace and growth in virtue, a time that we invest in our relationship with God and focus on responding to his grace whole-heartedly.

Receiving Holy Communion on the Tongue

Recently I was asked by a parishioner; "Father, what is the correct way to receive Communion on the tongue?"

The following is the best practices for receiving on the tongue:

The individual should stand before the minister who is distributing the Body of Jesus. Stand about as close as necessary as if you were to receive the host on the hand. After the priest says "The Body of Christ", reply "Amen" and then tilt your head back, open your mouth, and extend your tongue. Keep your head still and wait for the host to be placed on your tongue. Do not attempt to "catch" the host from the priest, and do not close your mouth until the host has been placed on your tongue. You must be very steady and wait until the host is placed on your tongue before moving.

The faithful can receive communion on the tongue at any point in the communion line. However, at St. Paul's, we are asking those to come to a member of the clergy (a priest or deacon) to receive on the tongue rather than an extraordinary minister of communion, who will always give on the hand for the time being.

Update on Collective Mass intentions

Currently we have 3 Masses per week where we accept collective (multiple) Mass intentions: Tuesday evening, Wednesday Morning, and Saturday evening. **Starting July 1, 2023**, there will be a change in the Masses and number of intentions to be in accordance with the Diocesan Guidelines for Collective Masses intentions. Beginning on July 1, Collective Mass Intentions will be on Saturday at the 9am Mass, and Saturday at the 5pm Mass each week. A maximum of 10 Intentions will be taken for each Mass. The other weekday Masses will still have a single intention. Thank you for your understanding as we make this change.

New Reconciliation Room

The construction project for the new Reconciliation Room is completed. The former storage closet has been converted into the new reconciliation room with an entrance from the nave (main area) of the church. The green light above the door indicates a priest is available to hear confessions. Penitents can line up along the wall near the new door and wait until the reconciliation room is vacant before entering.
