Day of Prayer for Sexual Abuse Victims

March 5th, the 2nd Sunday of Lent has been decreed as a day of Prayer for the Victims of Sexual Abuse in our diocese. We encourage all the faithful to pray the following prayer for all victims.

Prayer for the Victims & Survivors of Sexual Abuse

Father, since your mercy has been revealed in the tenderness of your Son, Jesus Christ, who said to His disciples: "suffer the little children to come unto me," we pray that your Church may be a secure home where all children and vulnerable adults are brought closer to your Beloved Son. May all those who have been abused physically, emotionally, and sexually by your ministers, be respected and accompanied by tangible gestures of justice and reparation so that they may feel healed with the balm of your compassion. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

Heavenly Father, who loves and cares for all your children, especially the smallest and most vulnerable, we entrust to you the lives of the many children and vulnerable adults, who have been sexually abused, and whose trust and innocence have been destroyed. Help us to hear their cries of pain, and to take responsibility for so many broken lives.

We pray that within their communities and families. They may be healed, and they may again know peace.

Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who shared our weakness in all things but sin, and lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit for ever and ever. Amen.

Receiving Holy Communion on the Tongue

The faithful can receive communion on the tongue at any point in the communion line. However, we are asking those who wish to receive on the tongue to come to a member of the clergy (a priest or deacon) rather than an extraordinary minister of communion, who will always give on the hand for the time being.

Update on Collective Mass intentions

Currently we have 3 Masses per week where we accept collective (multiple) Mass intentions: Tuesday evenings, Wednesday mornings, and Saturday evenings. **Beginning on July 1, 2023**, there will be a change in the Masses and number of intentions to be in accordance with the Diocesan Guidelines for Collective Mass intentions. Beginning on July 1, Collective Mass Intentions will be on Saturdays at the 9am Mass, and Saturdays at the 5pm Mass each week. A maximum of 10 intentions will be taken for each Mass. All other weekday Masses will still be offered for a single intention. Thank you for your understanding as we make this change.
