Evenings With His Excellency

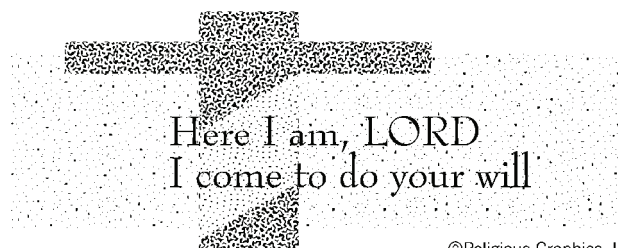
