<u>Update on Collective Mass intentions</u>

Currently we have 3 Masses per week where we accept collective (multiple) Mass intentions: Tuesday evening, Wednesday Morning, and Saturday evening. **Beginning on July 1, 2023**, there will be a change in the Masses and number of intentions to be in accordance with the Diocesan Guidelines for Collective Masses intentions.
