The Pope intended it to be a day dedicated to the celebration, reflection and dissemination of the Word.

This is a fitting day to have a recognition and presentation of the mandates for our parish Lectors who attended the Lector formation on November 20. At each Mass, the lectors who are present will receive their mandate to carry out this ministry in our parish for 3 years. We thank all the Lectors for their ongoing commitment to our parish and this ministry.

Did you know? #4

After the priest and the people make the sign of the cross, the priest greets the people with one of three greetings. The longest greeting "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the Love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all" is from Paul's letter to the Corinthians (2 Cor 13:14). This is a reminder that through our baptism, each of us has a relationship with each of the divine Persons. It is through the Son that we come to the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit. This greeting also draws our attention to the Trinitarian dimension of the Liturgy and that we enter into the intimacy of the Trinity when we participate in the Mass. For the priest, it is a great experience to greet you at Mass, and to desire the communion of the Holy Spirit to be with you!

The other option for the greeting that is sometimes used "Grace to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ" is the beginning of eight of the letters from St. Paul (Rom 1:7; 1 Cor 1:3; 2 Cor 1:2; Gal 1:3; Eph 1:2; Phil 1:2; 2 Thess 1:2; Phlm 3). It is a greeting and an invitation into the presence of God – the grace and peace of God is present to us, and we are invited to enter into and respond to the grace and peace of God.

The people reply to the greeting "And with your spirit." This response is also found in the letters of Paul (Gal 6:18; Phil 4:23; 2 Tim 4:22). This response was updated in 2011 from "and also with you" to better acknowledge the priest's role in the liturgy. By responding, "And with your spirit," we acknowledge the Spirit's activity through the priest during the sacred Liturgy. We know that God works through the priest, and ultimately it is Jesus who is the head of our community, but we acknowledge the priest's distinct role to act in the person of Christ during the Liturgy which comes through his ordination and the power of the Holy Spirit.

With our new camera system, there may be times during the livestreamed Masses where you will be visible on the video feed. By attending the 9am Masses on Sunday, and other Masses that we livestream, you consent to having video footage taken by representatives of St. Paul the Apostle Parish and allow your likeness to be reproduced in materials that may be developed by The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of the Diocese of Hamilton in Ontario, including Parish and Diocesan websites and social media platforms.
