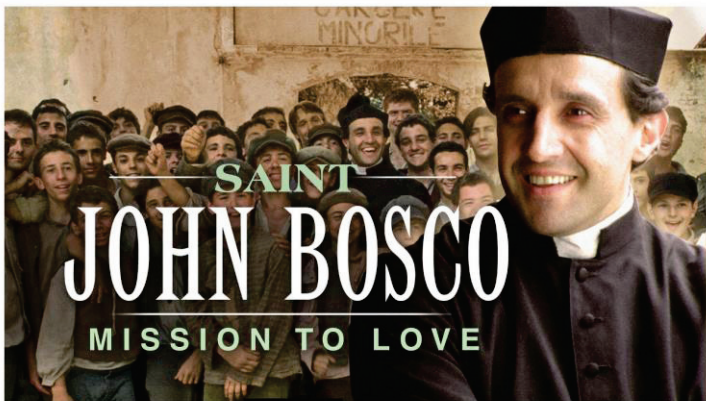
Bishop Farrell Library and Archives

Materials can be used for parish programming, small faith group sharing, youth ministry and catechesis, or general enrichment. The Library is open to all members of the community.

Our **Archival records** present a history of the Catholic Church in Ontario, as well as, an account of the people in the region, providing a rich resource for researchers, genealogists, and students. We maintain collections for our 120 Parishes plus current and past bishops, as well as, collections for our diocesan institutions and organizations.

Reel Justice Film Festival






