Papal Visit to Canada

THE VATICAN HAS CONFIRMED the program of the Papal Visit to Canada, July 24-29, 2022! The Holy Father will travel within Alberta (based in Edmonton) from July 24-27, followed by a visit to Quebec City and Ste. Anne-de-Beaupre, July 27-29. Pope Francis will visit Iqaluit, Nunavut, the afternoon of July 29th, before returning to Rome. Drawing on the theme, "Walking Together", the Holy Father's journey of reconciliation, healing and hope includes visits to a former residential school, Indigenous pilgrimage sites, two public Masses and mix of public and private events. Free tickets will be available for a limited number of events, all of which will be broadcast and accessible via livestream. SSVP Monthly PAD Change as of August

The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul (SSVP) wants to take this opportunity to thank those who donate monthly through the St. Paul the Apostle pre-authorized debit program (PAD). Monthly donations are needed now more than ever due to the increased demand for regular monthly assistance to our neighbours.

Effective for your August 2022 PAD, the SSVP portion of your monthly PAD will be withdrawn from your bank account using our new SSVP payment processing platform. The SSVP and church are separate entities with separate banking arrangements and this change recognizes and facilitates that distinction. Letters were mailed from SSVP to each SSVP monthly donor the week of July 11th. This mailing includes an authorization form to be completed and returned by August 15th. SSVP cannot continue to withdraw your monthly PAD donation as of August if this form is not received, so kindly watch for this letter. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and generosity.
