World Youth Day – Lisbon July 28 – August 7, 2023



Papal Visit to Canada

THE VATICAN HAS CONFIRMED the program of the Papal Visit to Canada, **July 24-29, 2022!** The Holy Father will travel within Alberta (based in Edmonton) from July 24-27, followed by a visit to Quebec City and Ste. Anne-de-Baupre, July 27-29. Pope Francis will visit Iqaluit, Nunavut, the afternoon of July 29th, before returning to Rome. Drawing on the theme, "Walking Together", the Holy Father's journey of reconciliation, healing and hope includes visits to a former residential school, Indigenous pilgrimage sites, two public Masses and mix of public and private events. Free tickets will be available for a limited number of events, all of which will be broadcast and accessible via livestream. The Knights of Columbus

THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS is an international organization of Catholic men committed to improving the lives of other Catholic men and their families. They are lively organizations in many Parishes throughout our Diocese, across Canada, and around the world. Founded by Blessed Father Michael McGivney in New Haven, Connecticut, in 1882, the Order has spread to many countries worldwide. The Knights have been in Ukraine for twelve years and even longer in Poland. When Russia advanced on Ukraine, Ukrainian members of the Knights and those in Poland immediately began to bring relief to the innocent victims of war. They helped get basic necessities to besieged cities and aid to those who were dispersed – including bringing refugees to Poland. The day following the invasion, Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly promised prayer and action – and it happened! By mid-March, \$6.5 million dollars was raised and sent for the aid of displaced persons and refugees! The Knights know how to spring into action. When a man becomes a Knight, especially if he also participates in the insurance program, he not only has a first-class insurance policy to protect his family, but he also becomes an essential partner in all the works of the Knights. Without their membership the Knights could do nothing. It is even better if he is active in his own Council, serving the community.

Ministry Update, Summer 2022

Music Ministry – Tyler Seidenberg hopes to restart the parish choir! In the late summer further information will be shared regarding sign up, as well as more specific details including schedules etc. Please watch the website and bulletin for updates in the coming months.

Altar Servers – we intend to bring back Altar Servers to Sunday masses starting in the fall. We are working on a plan for scheduling and training. Later in the summer we will communicate the plan in the bulletin and website and via email to all who served the ministry in the past. We will also recruit new servers (those entering Grade 4 or higher in the fall) to be part of this liturgical ministry.

Children's Liturgy – we plan to restart Children's Liturgy in Fall, 2022. Like other ministries which remain on pause, it requires planning and retraining before it can begin again. The website and bulletin will have updates and our ministry leaders will reach out to those who assisted in the past and will also be seeking new volunteers to help in the future.
