

## Update on Parish Upgrades

We are planning some upgrades in the parish in the coming months.

The **parking lot** resealing and repainting has been completed. Thanks to everyone for their patience. The City of Burlington has planted 8 new trees next to Headon Road in front of the church. The city owns the strip of grass between the sidewalk and street, and we look forward to the new trees growing and providing shade along the sidewalk and street for many years.

One of the most notable upgrades that will be coming is the **main entrance to the church**. We have raised money from the capital campaign for new doors, and other features that we're considering are a roof overhang or canopy above the main doors, cutting down the curb for ease of entrance with strollers and walkers, and a keypad for after-hours entry. As the replacement of the doors of the church is a high priority, and I hope to begin this project as soon as possible.

Another area of improvement will be the **office area**. Reconfiguring the office spaces to make them more usable and installing a counter and "service window" are being considered. The side chapel that we currently use for reconciliation will remain as it is for the time being.

In the church, there are plans for a **new confessional** made from the storage closet by the picture of our Lady of Guadeloupe. This will be a proper reconciliation room with adequate space for social distancing, more privacy and sound insulation, and accessible from the church area by a door cut into the wall near the 6<sup>th</sup> Station of the Cross.


We are continuing to work with the lighting contractors on upgrading the **lights in the church, hall, office, and parking lot**. The sample light that is installed at the back of the church has been well received, and we look forward to completing this project before too long.

We have also raised money from the capital campaign to replace the **carpet in the church**. At this time, the Diocese is not permitting carpet to be installed in churches and is requiring that all renovations and new constructions have flooring installed. Following the installation of the new floor, we will have sound technicians come and adjust the sound system to compensate for the change in the acoustic environment.

## Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

The Feast of Corpus Christi is the second Sunday after Pentecost – this year it is celebrated on **June 18-19**. Although we celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ at each Mass, this Feast is a day where we celebrate with extra solemnity and devotion the great mystery of the Holy Eucharist, the very Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ hidden under the appearance of bread and wine. This Feast has been in the church since the 13<sup>th</sup> century, and oftentimes is celebrated in parishes with outdoor processions of the Blessed Sacrament.

At all Masses this weekend, our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who completed their training at our November and March sessions will receive their mandates from the Bishop. This is a fitting day for them to receive recognition and renew their dedication to this ministry.


