### <u>Update on Parish Upgrades</u>

We are planning some upgrades in the parish in the coming months.

One of the most notable upgrades that will be coming is the main entrance to the church. We have raised money from the capital campaign for new doors, and other features that we're considering are a roof overhang or canopy above the main doors, cutting down the curb for ease of entrance with strollers and walkers, and a keypad for after-hours entry. As the replacement of the doors of the church is a high priority, and I hope to begin this project as soon as possible. New sod has been placed where the crab apple trees were removed earlier this month.

Another area of improvement will be **the office area**. Reconfiguring the office spaces to make them more usable and installing a counter and "service window" are being considered. The side chapel that we currently use for reconciliation will remain as it is for the time being.

In the church, there are plans for a new confessional made from the storage closet by the picture of our Lady of Guadeloupe. This will be a proper reconciliation room with adequate space for social distancing, more privacy and sound insulation, and accessible from the church area by a door cut into the wall near the  $6^{\text{th}}$  Station of the Cross.

We are continuing to work with the lighting contractors on upgrading the **lights in the church**, **hall**, **office**, **and parking lot**. The sample light that is installed at the back of the church has been well received, and we look forward to completing this project before too long.

We have also raised money from the capital campaign to replace the carpet in the church. At this time, the Diocese is not permitting carpet to be installed in churches and is requiring that all renovations and new constructions have flooring installed. Following the installation of the new floor, we will have sound technicians come and adjust the sound system to compensate for the change in the acoustic environment.

# Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

The Feast of Corpus Christi is the second Sunday after Pentecost – this year it is celebrated on **June 18-19**. Although we celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ at each Mass, this Feast is a day where we celebrate with extra solemnity and devotion the great mystery of the Holy Eucharist, the very Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ hidden under the appearance of bread and wine. This Feast has been in the church since the 13th century, and oftentimes is celebrated in parishes with outdoor processions of the Blessed Sacrament.

At all Masses this weekend, our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who completed their training at our November and March sessions will receive their mandates from the Bishop. This is a fitting day for them to receive recognition and renew their dedication to this ministry.

### Save the date for Special Mass and Parish B.B.Q.

Mark Saturday June 25th on your calendar! The 5:00 pm mass on this date will be a Mass of memoriam in honor of former pastors Rev. Paul Boucher and Rev. Bob Stainsby, both of whom passed away in 2021. Both priests served in St. Paul the Apostle for many years, and Father Paul was our founding pastor. Due to the pandemic their funerals were restricted, so this Mass is being offered to provide all parishioners a chance to remember their lives of priestly service and commitment.

Following the 5pm mass the Parish BBQ returns after a pandemic hiatus! Details regarding this event will be posted here in the coming weeks. This weekend also marks Father Gregory's final weekend with us before he moves to Canadian Martyrs parish Hamilton. Please come out and say thank you and farewell to him!

### Ministry Update, Summer 2022

**Music Ministry** – Tyler Seidenberg hopes to restart the parish choir! In the late summer further information will be shared regarding sign up, as well as more specific details including schedules etc. Please watch the website and bulletin for updates in the coming months.

Altar Servers – we intend to bring back Altar Servers to Sunday masses starting in the fall. We are working on a plan for scheduling and training. Later in the summer we will communicate the plan in the bulletin and website and via email to all who served the ministry in the past. We will also recruit new servers (those entering Grade 4 or higher in the fall) to be part of this liturgical ministry.

Children's Liturgy – we plan to restart Children's Liturgy in Fall, 2022. Like other ministries which remain on pause, it requires planning and retraining before it can begin again. The website and bulletin will have updates and our ministry leaders will reach out to those who assisted in the past and will also be seeking new volunteers to help in the future.
