RCIA This Week

On March 17th at the 11am mass, the Elect, those in RCIA who are to be baptized at the Easter Vigil, participated in the Third Scrutiny. The weekend Gospel story of Jesus raising his friend Lazarus from the dead, fills all of us with the hope of life-giving Spirit and prepares us for our birth to new life as promised to us in Baptism.

Chrism Mass

The Chrism Mass will be held at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King on **Monday, March 25, 2024, at 2:00 pm**. No reservation or registration is necessary. The Chrism Mass is where the Sacred Chrism, the Oil of the Sick, and the Oil of Catechumens are blessed by the Bishop for the use in all the parishes throughout the year. This Chrism Mass is also where all the priests of the diocese gather and renew their commitment and promises as priests of the diocese. "This Mass, which the Bishop concelebrates with his presbyterate, should be, as it were, a manifestation of the Priests' communion with their Bishop." (Roman Missal) Traditionally, this Mass is held on Holy Thursday, but because of parish schedules and the distance many priests travel to attend, it is usually celebrated on the Monday of Holy Week in our diocese. If you cannot attend, please pray for all the priests on that day.

Children's Liturgy

Children's Liturgy, offered each Sunday during the 9:00am Mass for children in JK to Grade 2, will take a break March 17 (school break) as well as March 24th (Palm Sunday) and March 31st (Easter Sunday). We look forward to welcoming children back to this special liturgy service starting again on April 7th.

Crosses and Statues

This week, the crosses and statues in the church will be covered until the celebration of Easter. This is done during the final two weeks of Lent to heighten our senses and awareness that Easter is fast approaching. We "fast" from looking at the beauty of our church as we enter the final days of our Lenten preparation, and to grow in the anticipation of Easter Sunday.


The Dismas' Plea
