### Update on Collective Mass intentions

Currently we have 3 Masses per week where we accept collective (multiple) Mass intentions: Tuesday evenings, Wednesday mornings, and Saturday evenings. **Beginning July 1<sup>st</sup>**, there will be a change in the Masses and number of intentions to be in accordance with the Diocesan Guidelines for Collective Mass intentions.
