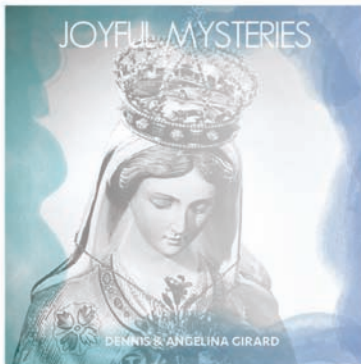
CWL Food Drive
