# Getting Baptized at St. Paul's

If you are seeking baptism for your child, please complete the Request for Baptism form found on our parish website and email to <a href="mailto:aouellette@hamiltondiocese.com">aouellette@hamiltondiocese.com</a> or drop off in person at the parish office.

Normally, a child is baptized in the parish where they live or the parish where they practice their faith. If you are not a parishioner, we can accommodate you only if, for a serious reason, you are unable to have your child baptized in your home parish.

If your child is age 8 or older please contact Arden Ouellette at the parish office for information regarding your child's baptism. Children of this age are required to complete the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC) program before being baptized.

Once your Request for Baptism has been reviewed you will receive a call or email to confirm your information and provide details about the Baptism Preparation program. At that time, you will be able to choose a date and time for the preparation sessions as well as a date of baptism. At this time, all of our slots are full until the end of the summer.

Parents seeking baptism for their children will be required to attend 2 inperson preparation meetings. Meetings will be held on Wednesday evenings, approximately one month apart. Parents are encouraged to bring their children to the meetings.

Meeting 1: a session to provide parents with the important information about the sacrament of Baptism and the role and responsibility that the parents take on presenting their child for baptism (approx. 40 minutes).

Meeting 2: a rehearsal in the church to walk through the steps of the celebration and to ensure all parents are well prepared for the sacrament date (approx. 30 minutes)

The Celebration of Baptism follows the  $2^{nd}$  Meeting on Sunday at 2:00 pm.

### Fr. Malcolm Katzenberger is Retiring

Many parishioners will remember Fr. Malcolm Katzenberger from his time as an associate at St. Paul's from 2009-2012. Currently he is Pastor at St. Gregory's Catholic Parish in Cambridge, and he will be retiring at the end of June. As of **June 29**, **2022**, he will be living in residence at St. Paul's. Fr. Malcolm plans to assist with many of the church and school activities in the parish, and he is excited to be returning to Burlington. We welcome Fr. Malcolm back to St. Paul's, and wish him well in his retirement and priestly ministry.

### National Rosary for the Family

The first every National Rosary for the Family will be held on **Sunday**, **June 19**th across the country, starting at 3pm EST (chosen to accommodate the various time zones across the country). This project has been planned as part of the preparation of the 10th World Meeting of Families (WMF) being held from **June 22-26**, **2022**. The CCCB Standing Committee for Family and Life is hosting this live and nationwide Rosary for the Family via Zoom Webinar. It is the hope of the Standing Committee for Family and Life that this moment will be an opportunity to gather at the national level in prayer as well as to witness alongside other faith-filled families. # **Updates on Parish Upgrades**

Recently we had some electrical contractors come in and provide quotes for updating the lights in the Church, hall, office, and parking lot. The plan is to retrofit the light fixtures in the church with LED bulbs. Currently the large, upper lights are 500W each, and the lower lights in the church are 200W each. The new LEDs will be 40W and 20W each and produce much more light than what is currently installed. You may see in the coming weeks one or two lights replaced so that we can see how they function and look in our church.

The office and hall will be updated with LED panels replacing the fluorescent panels, and LED "pot" lights to replace the current pot lights. The parking lot will have LED flood lights installed on the light poles. This will provide much better illumination than the old and dim lights that are currently installed. Those who come to the 8pm Mass in the winter know how dark the parking lot is at night, even with all the exterior lights on.

Finally, we had a contractor come in to start the process installing new doors at the entrance way, new flooring in the church, and some small renovations in the office area. I am glad that the projects that we have raised money for in the "One Heart One Soul" campaign are finally underway. I hope to start the most essential projects this summer and will keep you updated on progress as it continues. Fr. John
