Update on Envelopes and Tax Receipts

As more people are using Pre-Authorized debit or e-transfer, we are able to significantly reduce the number of envelopes that are issued, saving the parish almost \$1000 in envelope costs. As a result of this reduction, all envelope users will have a new envelope number for 2024. Envelopes will be re-issued in 2024 for parishioners who have contributed a minimum of \$50 in the last year. If you do not have envelopes and wish to use them, please contact the office. The 2024 tax receipts will be issued for those who contributed \$50 or more in 2023 and may be issued by request for amounts less than \$50. We sincerely thank all donors for their ongoing financial support of our parish.
