From the Pastor's Desk

Some people have asked about the remark I made in last week's bulletin about the posture at Mass. Below is an explanation on the reason why the faithful are not to pray with their hands extended (called the orans posture) during the Mass. This posture is for the priest celebrant because he acts in the person of Christ at Mass it is Christ himself present at the altar through the priest. The priest, therefore, prays on behalf of the people in a way that is distinct from the other faithful at Mass. Because of his unique and essential role in the Mass, the priest is to observe a distinct posture, he wears distinct clothes (vestments), he has a distinct chair and place in the sanctuary, and he prays with distinct prayers that are to be observed by only him when celebrating the Mass. Likewise, the faithful have their own prescribed roles, posture, seats and prayers that they observe during Mass. The General Instruction for the Roman Missal indicates that the priest is to pray the Our Father with his hands extended. It does not indicate that the people are to do so as well. Any mixing or confusion between the roles of the celebrant and the faithful at Mass is to be avoided.

The Roman curia, the administrative body of the Holy See, clarified the necessity of the distinction of roles with the following: "In Eucharistic celebrations deacons and non-ordained members of the faithful may not pronounce prayers – e.g. especially the Eucharistic prayer, with its concluding doxology – or any other parts of the liturgy reserved to the celebrant priest. Neither may deacons or non-ordained members of the faithful use gestures or actions which are proper to the same priest celebrant."

There are many cases where people pray with their hands extended, for example Protestant worship services. Charismatic groups, etc. The orans posture is biblical (e.g. Psalm 28, 63, and 134) and can be a wonderful way to engage our body in prayer. Anyone is free to pray as they wish when they are alone or in a gathering where the orans posture is normative, but when we come to Mass, the Church has guidelines and reasons for what is permitted by the priest and people.

I believe that it's important to know why we do, or don't do things at Mass. Through a deeper understanding of why we do things, I hope that we can come to a fuller appreciation of the beauty of the liturgy and give glory to God through our common worship.

Indulgences for November

By a decree on October 28, the Apostolic Penitentiary in Rome has extended to the entire month of November the possibility of obtaining plenary indulgences for the Holy Souls in Purgatory through the performance of specific indulgenced works.

A member of the faithful can either:

- 1. visit a cemetery during which prayer is offered for the faithful departed; or
- visit a church or oratory during which one Our Father and one Creed are recited.

For each indulgence, the person obtaining the indulgence for the faithful departed must (1) be in a state of grace and detached completely from sin, (2) receive Holy Communion, (3) pray for the intentions of the Pope, and (4) receive the sacrament of confession in the 20 days before or after the indulgenced work.




