All sign-ups are on a first come basis and we ask that you sign up only once during the Advent season.

Update on Envelopes and Tax Receipts

The 2024 offertory envelopes will be in the Narthex early December. As more people are using Pre-Authorized debit or e-transfer, we are able to significantly reduce the number of envelopes that are issued, saving the parish almost \$1000 in envelope costs. As a result of this reduction, **all envelope users will have a new envelope number for 2024**. Envelopes will be re-issued in 2024 for parishioners who have contributed a minimum of \$50 in the last year. If you do not have envelopes and wish to use them, please contact the office. The 2024 tax receipts will be issued for those who contributed \$50 or more in 2023 and may be issued by request for amounts less than \$50. We sincerely thank all donors for their ongoing financial support of our parish.
