#### From the Pastor's Desk

This week we have published in the bulletin and on our parish website the Mass schedule for Christmas and New Year's. This year, Christmas falls on a Saturday, so it will be a very busy 3 days for the pastoral team as we celebrate Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, and the Feast of the Holy Family on consecutive days. Previously, we have had a concurrent Mass in the parish hall for the busiest Christmas Masses, but this year we will be streaming a live feed from the church into the hall. This is being done for a few reasons. Most parishes that have overflow seating have a live feed, so our previous ability to have a concurrent Mass was the exception to the norm. Secondly, our volunteers are already stretched thin, and we do not have enough help for additional musicians, ushers, and readers. For those who want a seat in the church, plan to come early Christmas Eve, or come on Christmas morning when we typically have adequate space. Note that we are not taking any reservations for the Christmas Masses this year, so it will be on a first-come basis, and when the church and hall are full we will begin. May everyone have a blessed Advent as we prepare to welcome the newborn Christ into our hearts at Christmas!


