Return of the Altar Servers

This weekend we welcome back our altar servers. There are a couple changes that you may notice. One is that the processional cross will be out of sight during the Mass. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal states that "The cross adorned with a figure of Christ crucified, and carried in procession, may be placed next to the altar to serve as the altar cross, in which case it must be the only cross used; otherwise it is put away in a dignified place." (*GIRM 122*) The intention of this directive is that there is only one cross depicting crucified Christ in the sanctuary. As we already have a cross on the altar, the processional cross will be out of sight during Mass.

The altar servers will also be holding the lighted candles adjacent to the ambo during the proclamation of the Gospel. We have not done this at St. Paul's in the past, but it is a common practice in many parishes. "The reading of the Gospel constitutes the high point of the Liturgy of the Word. The Liturgy itself teaches the great reverence that is to be shown to this reading by setting it off from the other readings with special marks of honour." (*GIRM 60*) The usual way to honour the Gospels when there are altar servers is with a short procession from the altar to the ambo, and then the acolytes will remain holding the candles for the duration of the Gospel.

November Indulgences

In the month of November, the Church grants additional ways to gain an indulgence for the souls in Purgatory. A plenary indulgence can be obtained once per day and applied to oneself or a soul in Purgatory. The usual conditions for an indulgence are:

1. Complete an act to which the Church has granted an indulgence (see below).

- 2. Go to confession within 20 days of completing the act.
- 3. Offer prayers for the Holy Father on the day you complete the act.
- 4. Receive communion on the day you complete the act.

5. Be free from all attachment to sin, even venial sin. If this is not possible, then the indulgence is partial rather than plenary.

The acts which are specific to November that have indulgences attached are:

- Between Nov. 1-8, visit a cemetery and pray for the dead.
- On Nov. 2, visit a church or oratory and pray the Creed and an Our Father.
