Update on the Refugee Family

Our Parish is in the process of sponsoring a refugee family from Jordan in the Middle East. The process was started in 2018, and between complications arising from the government in the departing country and the Covid-19 pandemic, the family's arrival into Canada has been repeatedly delayed. In the last couple of weeks, we have received notice that they are in the final stages before being cleared to fly to Canada. We are working with the Diocesan Office for Refugees to review the sponsorship budget, update the settlement plan, and create a quarantine plan. If all continues to go well we can expect to welcome them in Canada in 2-3 months. We continue to pray for their safe arrival and future success in our country.

New AV system in the Parish Hall

We are currently installing a projector and screen in the parish hall, and a permanent camera in the church (parishioners with a keen eye may have noticed it installed in the last couple of weeks). This new system will give us the opportunity to stream events in the Church directly to the hall for overflow of Sunday Mass and liturgies at Christmas, the Triduum, and Easter. Presentations and conferences held in the hall will also benefit from this new system. The church camera system will allow us to livestream in a more elegant way than the cellphone system we are presently using. We look forward to everyone benefiting from these additions, both for those who watch from home, and those who are attending on Sundays.

<u>Indulgences for November</u>

By a decree on October 28, the Apostolic Penitentiary in Rome has extended to the entire month of November the possibility of obtaining plenary indulgences for the Holy Souls in Purgatory through the performance of specific indulgenced works.

A member of the faithful can either:

- 1. visit a cemetery during which prayer is offered for the faithful departed; or
- 2. visit a church or oratory during which one Our Father and one Creed are recited.

For each indulgence, the person obtaining the indulgence for the faithful departed must (1) be in a state of grace and detached completely from sin, (2) receive Holy Communion, (3) pray for the intentions of the Pope, and (4) receive the sacrament of confession in the 20 days before or after the indulgenced work.

. From the Pastor's Desk

As a community of believers, we are united in our common faith, common prayers, and common worship. We are also united in the way which we express ourselves through our posture at Mass. The Church has directives on the proper posture that we are to observe when we worship together. If there were no quidelines, then it would be chaos and distracting as some people stand, or sit, or kneel whenever they wanted to. Everyone is free to pray as they want to when in private such as at home, but during Mass, we are asked to observe what the Church has indicated to be proper for these liturgical celebrations. The faithful are reminded that in the Diocese of Hamilton, everyone is to remain standing during the Lamb of God, and that while receiving Communion everyone is encouraged to observe a common posture of standing. During the Our Father, only the priest is permitted to pray with his hands extended. May God bless us for our humble obedience to his Church.

Lector and Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion training dates

For all Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) of St. Paul's, you will be required to attend a training session led by Deacon John Moss, the director of Liturgy for the Diocese of Hamilton. This date has been set to be **Saturday**, **November 20**, **2021** and will be held at St. Paul's. The Lector training will be from **10:00am to 12:30pm**, and the EMHC training will be from **1:30pm to 4:00pm**.

These ministries are of great importance and dignity in the liturgy, so it is necessary that all ministers are trained appropriately and regularly. These ministries are so serious that the Bishop issues mandates to those who are properly trained. Lector and EMHC mandates have a 3 year term and are renewable at the pastor's discretion. The Bishop is required to ensure that all Lectors and EMHC are properly trained; therefore, all Lectors and EMHC at St. Paul's will be expected to have a mandate to carry out these ministries. Those who attend the training session(s) on **November 20** will have mandates issued for your ministry.

If you are currently not active as a Lector or EMHC but may want to resume your ministry in the coming months, you are invited to participate in the training now so that you can partake in your ministry when you are ready.

For those who take communion in a pyx to a family member at home or to a seniors' residence, this is also a function of an EMHC; you will therefore need the proper training and mandate to continue this practice. There will be some additional items covered during the training for taking communion to the homebound.
