Gaudete Sunday

"May brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord always. I say it again: rejoice! Your kindness should be known to all. The Lord is near" (Phil 4:4).

"The Third Sunday of Advent, which we are celebrating today, is called "Gaudete Sunday" according to the liturgical tradition. That comes from the first word of

the passage from Paul's letter to the Philippians which was read a little while ago, which begins with the exhortation: "Rejoice".

The Christian community expresses its joy at the coming of the Lord's birth. In just a few days, in fact, the events at Bethlehem will be before our eyes, and in our hearts and prayers. They are wondrous events in which we see the figures of Mary, the Mother of God, who gives birth to her only-begotten Son and Joseph the just man, Jesus' foster father, who silently provides for the needs of the Holy Family; then there are the angels who sing in chorus to the shepherds who hurry and find the infant whom they had been told about. Around these events there in an atmosphere of joy, in accordance with the words of the angel: "I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people."
