LIVING THE "YEAR OF FAITH" **REFLECTION ON THE**

CHRISTIAN VOCATION

'Father John Hugo, a friend and counselor to Dorothy Day, once wrote that the real Jesus "did not hesitate to condemn the rich, to warn the powerful, to denounce in vehement language the very leaders of the people. Christ's love and goodness were chiefly for the poor, the simple, the needy. And His love for them was not a limp, indulgent love, like that of a silly, frivolous mother. To his friends, He preached poverty of spirit, detachment, the carrying the cross. No more did the kindness of Jesus spare His followers, than the kindness of God the Father spared His Son. And we are to drink of the same chalice that He drank of."

Does that sound anything like the actual tone of Catholic life in our country today? I suspect not. 
