

ASH WEDNESDAY March 1, 2017

Ashes will be blessed and distributed at 6:30 a.m., 8:00 a.m., and 7:00 p.m.

Masses. Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence from meat. Fasting means cutting down noticeably on the food we eat and abstinence means abstaining from meat. Lent marks our entrance into a time of a more intense attention to our friendship with God and charity to our neighbor. This time of special grace will pass quickly. Hence we must make a plan personally tailored according to our needs and obligations. We encourage you to take into account the following activities of our parish during this important time. The FNE would like to invite parishioners to join them in praying the *Rosary after Ash Wednesday evening Mass.*

6:00 pm Penitential Meal 7:00 pm Stations of the Cross Immediately followed by Mass

On Fridays during Lent we will be having a *penitential meal* of soup, bread and water at 6:00 pm in the parish hall. There will be an 'ask-it-basket' with all proceeds going to different charities. All are welcome.

Each Friday before we begin our Stations of the Cross,

you are invited to write out a personal petition and place it in a basket/bowl at the front. Not one of us is immune to struggles and difficulties in our lives, but as Christians we place our hope and trust in a loving God.

On these special Friday evenings, place these problems before Our Lord, and journey with him through his passion and death, knowing that each step of the way, he is walking beside you today and guiding you in all that you do. Paper and pencils will be provided at the back of the church. Only a few words are needed; no name is required. Simply fold the paper and place it in the basket. Your intentions will be remembered during the Masses of that week.
