

World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life

On **Wednesday, February 2**nd the Church celebrates the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. The purpose of this day is "to help the entire Church to esteem ever more greatly the witness of those persons who have chosen to follow Christ by means of the practice of the evangelical counsels" as well as "to be a suitable occasion for consecrated persons to renew their commitment and rekindle the fervour which should inspire their offering of themselves to the Lord" – Pope John Paul II, 1997 message.

In the Archdiocese of Toronto we are blessed to have living and serving among us more than 1,100 religious men and women of over 100 different religious congregations. This World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life is a wonderful opportunity for us to thank God for the gifts of these religious sisters, brothers and priests and to pray for God's blessing upon them in their efforts to faithfully live the evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity and obedience.

There will be a **special Mass next Sunday, January 30**th at 3:00 pm at St. Paul's Basilica in celebration of the vocation and witness of these special men and women religious who are such a vital and important part of the life and ministry of the Church in our Archdiocese. All are welcome to attend.

Catholics Rejoice in Announcement of Pope John Paul II Beatification

Pope Benedict XVI made the formal declaration in Rome that the late Pope John Paul II is one step closer to sainthood. Archbishop Thomas Collins conveyed his joy in the announcement: "We rejoice in the news that Pope John Paul II will be beatified on May 1, 2011. So many around the world, including Canadians touched by his pastoral visits to our country and archdiocese, continue to be inspired by this great and holy pope."

Beatification is a significant milestone in the ongoing process for sainthood, the final step prior to canonization. The Vatican's Congregation for the Causes of Saints opened the cause for John Paul II's sainthood shortly after his death in 2005, with Pope Benedict waiving the traditional five year waiting period. For beatification, a miracle attributed to the candidate for sainthood must be proven. In the late pontiff's case, the remarkable recovery of a French nun with Parkinson's disease was deemed a miracle. Following the beatification ceremony on May 1, the late pontiff will be referred to as Blessed John Paul II. To be canonized, a second miracle attributed to the intercession of John Paul II will need to be authenticated following beatification.
