## PRIEST AND MASS YEAR OF THE PRIEST

"Pope Benedict XVI proclaimed, as everyone knows, the Year for Priests (June 2009 – June 2010), on the occasion of the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the "dies natalis" of the holy Curé d'Ars. The purpose is "to deepen the commitment of

all priests to interior renewal for the sake of a stronger and more incisive witness to the Gospel in today's world".

St. John Mary Vianney, besides concretely representing a supreme model of the priesthood, always proclaimed with clarity and incomparable emphasis the dignity of the priesthood and the centrality of the ordained ministry in the heart of the Church. Drawing from his teachings, the Holy Father re-proposed these words of the saint: "O, how great is the priest! ... If he realized what he is, he would die {...} God obeys him: He utters a few words and the Lord descends from heaven at his voice, to be contained within a small host."

And again: "Without the Sacrament of Holy Orders, we would not have the Lord. Who put him there in that tabernacle? The priest. Who welcomed your soul at the beginning of your life? The priest. Who feeds your soul and gives it strength for its journey? The priest. Who will prepare it to appear before God, bathing it one last time in the blood of Jesus Christ? The priest, always the priest. And if this soul should happen to die {as a result of sin}, who will raise it up, who will restore its calm and peace? Again, the priest... After God, the priest is everything! {...} Only in heaven will he fully realize what he is."
