SOLEMNITY ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

"The Ascension of the Lord is the crowning of his resurrection. It is

his official entry into the glory which was due him after the humiliation of Calvary; the return to the Father which he had foretold on Easter day: "I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God" (Jn 20:17) were his words to Magadalen. And to the disciples of Emmaus he had said: "Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and so enter into his glory? (Lk 24:26). This shows he was not indicating a future return and glorification, but one that was immediate and already present because it was closely connected with the resurrection. Still, in order to strengthen the disciples in the faith, it was necessary for all to take place in a visible manner, as I did for the forty days after Easter. Those who had seen our Lord die on the cross, amid insults and jeers, must be witnesses to his final exaltation into heaven."

Month of June Sacred Heart of Jesus

..... "Christ speaks: "Learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart" (Mt 11:29).

Only once, perhaps, did the Lord Jesus refer to his own heart, in his own words. And he stressed this sole feature: "gentleness and lowliness": as if he meant that it is only in this way that he wishes to conquer man; that by means of "gentleness and lowliness" he wishes to be the King of hearts. The whole mystery of his reign was expressed. in these words. Gentleness and lowliness cover, in a certain sense, all the "riches" of the Redeemer's heart, of which St Paul wrote to the Ephesians. But also that "gentleness and lowliness" reveal him fully; and enable us to get to know him and accept him; they make him the object of supreme

The beautiful litany to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is composed of many similar words—more, exclamations of admiration for the riches of the Heart of Christ. This *Heart* is "A source of life and holiness".
