NOVENA ASKING INTERCESSION OF ST. JOSEPH

Beginning Thursday, March 10th until Saturday, March 19th, the Solemnity of St. Joseph, we shall have novena prayers at the end of

Mass. We shall also be speaking about the various saints and Blesseds of Quebec, along with the Oratory in Montreal which is honouring St. Joseph in bringing the holiness of these saints for our consideration. All should make a special effort to participate in Masses on the feast day of St. Joseph, Saturday, March 19th.

• SELF-CORRECTION •

"There is no shortage of critics who publicly point out how other people fail in their moral and religious duties. Many people are quick to reveal and judge the faults of others. This is particularly true of those who do not regard themselves as churchgoing Christians but consider themselves experts on how Christians are to behave, and see it as their duty as well as their pleasure to point out how individual Christians have fallen short of the standard. Even sectarian Christians distribute literature that attacks members of other churches for their shortcomings.

While a certain amount of criticism is understandable or justified – particularly of people who would never mend their ways unless they are made public – prominent fathers of the early undivided church stressed self-correction, i.e. examining one's own life for sins and failings, and then taking measures to correct them. This means more than just examining one's conscience or accusing oneself in the confessional; it includes knowing oneself and one's weaknesses and searching for ways to avoid sinning again. Self-correction and true repentance, Origen Adamatius taught his students, confers a benefit

on one's soul. A Christian does justice to his/her spiritual life, not by gazing outward or busying oneself with the sins and and activities of other people, but by turning inward and rendering true and frank evaluations of one's own life and behavior. The Christian must endeavour to know her/himself, and be so at home with oneself that they know their moral strengths and weaknesses and near occasions of sin. Origen taught that this was a practical application of the principle "know yourself', which he considered to be the highest practical achievement of Greek philosophers, who were still widely quoted and followed in his day, before Christianity became the majority religion. To succeed in the Christian life, Origen taught, one must hold up a mirror to oneself and see one's failings and weaknesses in it, and hopefully see a reflection of God as well. Origen was an important preacher and professor at prominent Christian educational institutions in the first half of the second century A.D. The first was at Alexandria in Egypt. Later he founded one of his own in Palestine, where he imparted higher spiritual knowledge to advanced students, such as that summarized in the last paragraph.

For the benefit of Christians besides his students, Origen wrote the first known text of Systematic Christian theology. In it he said that in order to receive more blessings from God a Christian must first come to a knowledge of her/himself and learn what are his/her character flaws and defects. To do this completely, a Christian may even need to find someone in the church who is especially qualified in the oversight and reconciliation of the soul with God, such as a spiritual director who can make up both for the Christian's deficiencies and for the Christian's failure to spot his/her own shortcomings.

Origen compared self-correction, or taking care of the health of one's soul, to taking care of the health of the body. If a Christian is not aware of a sickness or weakness, s/he does not know s/he is sick and will not seek a physician. Put another way, if a Christian is not first aware of his/her sinfulness and spiritual defects and does not admit them to him/herself, the Christian will not repent and thus will not be forgiven. The Christian may even incorrectly believe s/he is always free from sin and in no need of any correction or repentance. This leads to spiritual pride and failure to acknowledge that only God is the source of righteousness and blessings. The Christian will thus not repent, and thereby fall into spiritual ruin. Without the discipline of selfcorrection such a person loses the humility and simplicity God requires. Origen encouraged constant self-correction and mending one's ways by unceasing vigilance over one's soul and behavior. He openly stated that this involves struggles, and contests with the Devil, acquiring spiritually healthy habits, dogged perseverance in Christian life and virtues and correcting sins as soon as they are detected. This was all to be centred on one's own soul, without attention to the failings of other people. Nor did Origen grant any room for comparing oneself to other Christians in order to rationalize that s/he was not as sinful as they."
