March 25th Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord

Mary has the highest place in the Church after Christ because she is the Ever-Virgin Mother of Jesus Christ our Lord and God, and because she is our spiritual mother. The source of Mary's motherhood is the generous consent which she gave to the angel of the

Annunciation who had come to invite her to become the Mother of God; the Mother of God the Son. In the plan of God, the salvation of the world was made dependent on Mary's decision at that moment. She not only consented, but also willed, with a clear understanding of the meaning of the mission, that which was being confided to her.

The origin and foundation of the spiritual motherhood of Mary is intimately associated with the Incarnation. At the Incarnation, Mary gave Jesus to us. On Calvary, Jesus gave us His Mother, and He assigned to her a place near to Him, yet still of a secondary order, subordinated to Him. But this place, in relation to all mankind, is all-powerful, and unique. Christ, the Head Himself, has appointed her to be the mother of the Whole Christ, that is, of the Mystical Body of Christ the Church...From the earliest times the Blessed Virgin has been honored under the title of Mother of God, under whose protection the faithful take refuge together in prayer in all their perils and needs. Accordingly, following the Council of Ephesus, there was a remarkable growth in the cult of the People of God towards Mary, in veneration and love, in invocation and imitation, according to her own prophetic words: 'all generations shall call me blessed, because He that is mighty hath done great things to me' (Lk. 1:48-49).


