

June is Seniors Month in Ontario - There are 900 million persons in the world over the age of 60, and in Canada there are more persons over the age of 65 than children under the age of 15. Life expectancy has increased by 30 years over the past 100 years. Our potential for spiritual growth increases as we age. A new ministry is emerging in churches to support the faith development of "maturing adults" throughout the multiple transitions that mark the second half of life.
