<u>"Mothers' Day – May 9th,</u>

We express our prayers and gratitude for all mothers for goodness and love.

If through faith Mary became the bearer of the Son given to her by the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit, while preserving her virginity intact, in that same faith she discovered and accepted the other dimension of motherhood revealed by Jesus during His messianic mission. One can say that this dimension of motherhood belonged to Mary from the beginning, that is to say, from the moment of the conception and birth of her Son. From that time she was "the one who believed." But as the messianic mission of her Son grew clearer to her eyes and spirit, she herself as a mother became ever more open to that new dimension of motherhood which was to constitute her "part" beside her Son. Had she not said from the very beginning: "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be done to me according to your word." (Lk 1:38). Through faith, Mary continued to hear and to ponder that word, in which there became ever clearer, in a way "which surpasses knowledge" (Ep 3:19), the self-revelation of the living God. Thus in a sense, Mary as Mother became the first "disciple" of her Son, the first to whom He seemed to say: "Follow me," even before He addressed this call to the Apostles or to anyone else (cf. Jn 1:43).
