

Parish Update

"Work on the new tile floor and carpeting in the main hall is now complete. The total cost for asbestos remediation. carpet removal, environmental monitoring and air samples, storage container, new tile and carpet, including taxes came in at \$38,000. This was within the budget set for this project. Some of you have commented that depending where you look, the tile floor seems a little uneven. Be assured that the floor is fine and that you will see slight imperfections, because they existed before and were not as obvious with the old tile that had a pebbled pattern. There was the option to grind the existing concrete to get a smoother finish, or to flood the floor with a skim coat sealant, but this would have doubled the remediation costs from \$14,900 to almost \$30,000 with very little to show for the extra expenditure. Others have commented the tiled area looks smaller but this is incorrect. The exact same layout was reinstalled both for the carpet and the tile.

We have also remediated the boiler room at the same time as we saved money with the crew already onsite. The cost for asbestos removal, environmental monitoring and air samples including taxes was \$29,210. This was within the budget set for this project.

Many thanks to everyone for their patience and understanding while this work was completed. A special shout out to the many groups that use the hall that had to curtail their activities, and pack and unpack many boxes of items under tight time constraints.
