For a number of years now, our property manager has recommended that our almost 50 year old boilers and rapidly aging air conditioning systems be replaced. I am pleased to tell you that all necessary engineering is complete, building permits have been issued, and this work has now started. Our target date for startup is December 1st or earlier. We are required to bring our building up to current building code standards for ventilation. The total cost to do this is almost \$900,000 therefore we are only doing the boiler work at this time at a cost of \$400,000. We will have temporary heat in the church area shortly, but you may still find it cooler than usual, please dress accordingly. There are some roof repairs to be completed before the end of the year. This work is under warranty and therefore is at no cost to us. The other roof repairs required over the main hall door entrance will be scheduled for the spring, as we would not be able to finish them before winter arrives. These repairs are more extensive than expected and will cost approximately \$70,000 to complete. Thank you in advance for your patience as we undertake these latest improvements to our building systems.... Fr Ed.
