LIFE CHAIN

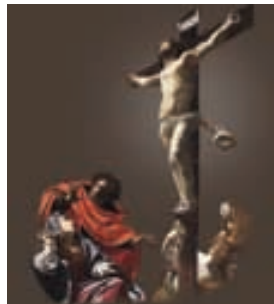
