ALPHA COURSE - ST CATHERINE OF SIENA!

When? In person classes every Wednesday starting November 8th at 7pm in the church. What is Alpha? The word "Alpha" comes from the first letter of the Greek alphabet and symbolizes a beginning or starting point of a journey. In the Bible, Jesus refers to Himself as the Alpha and Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end (Revelation 1:8,11; 21:6; 22:13). Some people ask why the Alpha Course starts with "Who is Jesus?" and not "Who is God?" The reason is that the Bible tells us it is through a relationship with Jesus that we can get to know God, experience his power, and know his character (John 1:14, John 14:6,9, Matthew 11:27). So, Alpha is the first step to exploring the big questions of life and discovering who Jesus is. It's an understanding of but also an encounter with the person of Jesus that is the most important part of what we believe. Alpha covers the basics of the Christian faith with a simple overview. 
