# Synod Update: "Enlarge the Space of Your <u>Tent"</u>

The local listening stages for the Synod of Bishops have been summarized in a document that will be used for the next Continental Stage of the Synod. This document presents a good picture of the concerns and issues of the church throughout the world. It is interesting to see that there are some unique issues in different parts of the world, but how many common concerns and issues are shared throughout the church in all parts of the world. The scriptural theme of the document is "Enlarge the Space of Your Tent" coming from a passage in Isaiah.
