Synod 2021 – 2023

Pope Francis has called for a world-wide church Synod. Synod is an ancient tradition in our church history which simply means "to journey together." It begins in 2021 with step 1 being the consultation and listening process at the local level. Every Diocese and all parishes are encouraged to have a listening process that engages as many people as possible. The Synod will conclude in 2023 with a special Synod of Bishops. The Diocese of Hamilton has prepared a survey to allow Catholics and other people to respond. Our parish has established a Synod Body of about 20 parishioners who will engage in this process. This Synod Body will then continue to serve our parish in a Praying Our Future process as we look to the future of our parish, especially as we enter the new church.
