This is the Top Ten list of 'most wanted items: canned fish and poultry (tuna or salmon, packed in water, chicken or turkey) baby food (jars of chicken, beef, vegetables or fruit, formula with added iron), canned fruit and vegetables packed in own juice, canned beans, chili or stew, peanut butter, whole grain pasta, whole wheat pasta, rice (brown, converted or parboiled), canned spaghetti sauce or tomatoes, cereal (high fiber, non-sugar coated), canned soup (lentil, pea, or vegetable). Please bring any of these items to church on Sunday and leave them in the Winnipeg Harvest Barrel.



In our faith, we have welcomed people in the sacrament of Baptism, have witnessed our children receive first reconciliation and communion, have walked down the aisle with many a bride and groom, have said so long to many of our beloved and we still gather week after week to praise our God on the day of the Lord. Our gathering reminded me of all that we have done together in our journey 'with God's help...'

As I leave, YOU COME WITH ME IN MY HEART. You have been patient with me, you have forgiven me, you have challenged me, you have fed me and you have shown the love that only a disciple of Jesus can show: ONE OF COMPLETE ACCEPTANCE. As a diocesan priest we do move around, and I am very grateful that Archbishop Weisgerber assigned me to St. Paul the Apostle.
