Ordinary Time – During ordinary time, the Church celebrates the fullness of he mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God praise Him by celebrating the paschal mystery of the death and resurection of Jesus. On the first day of the week, the Lord's day, God assembles His beloved people to hear His word, to reflect upon it, to offer a living sacrifice of praise, to eat and drink the banquet of the Lord. Then God sends them forth to proclaim this love by their words and actions. Sunday is the original Christian feast day, following the tradition handed down from the apostles' time, for this was the day of the Lord's Resurrection. Today's Christian communities continue this tradition by celebrating every Sunday as the day of the Risen Lord.

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity – is celebrated this year from Jan. 18 to Jan. 25. This universal prayer encourages Christians of all denominations to meet, to participate in various liturgical and other community activities, and to pray together that all may be one, as Christ desires. Unity among Christians is the responsibility of each parish.
