Feast of the Presentation of the Lord – Wed., February 2

The feast of the Presentation of the Lord is celebrated 40 days after Christmas. Part of its theme is that of 'light'. On Christmas, 'the light shines in the darkness' and only a few 'receive it' – Mary and the shepherds at the manger. On Epiphany the light casts its bright beams upon Jerusalem (the Church), "the glory of the Lord rises over Jerusalem," and the Gentiles come flocking out of the darkness to the City of Light. Lastly on the feast of the Presentation, candles are blessed to take to our homes, a symbol of the Light being brought to the ends of the earth.

Blessed Candles – are available to take home. Blessed candles are lit in homes as a sign of honour to Jesus Christ, who is the light of the world. Some may light them before a picture or image of a saint as a sign of our trust in God's protection in times of storms or danger.

Prayer for use with Blessed Candles

"Blessed are you, Lord our God, creator of the universe and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ; you have sent your son to be the light of the world, and to call us to be your people of light. Let these candles remind us of Jesus as we work with Him to build up your kingdom. By his grace may we please you always and come into eternal light with you and your saints.

Blessed and praised are you, God our Father, through Jesus Christ your Son in the love of your Holy Spirit, one God for ever and ever". Amen
